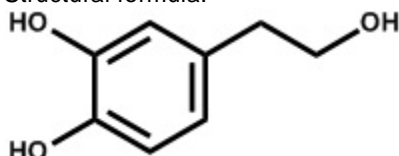

Hydroxytyrosol is an ingredient in olives, functioning as a highly active antioxidant in the body. Hydroxytyrosol is considered one of the most powerful antioxidants, its oxygen radical absorbance capacity is ten times that of green tea, and more than two times greater than that of CoQ10 and quercetin.

Storage
