

## Unilene BS-140

### Description:

Low molecular weight, thermoplastic aromatic C9 hydrocarbon resin obtained through catalytic polymerization in a continuous process, pastillated in a pearl-like shape and presented in soft yellow colored scale. Compatible with most solvents and polymeric materials.

In Rubbers, Unilene improves the processability of compounds, fillers incorporation, dispersion and tack of the mixture, avoiding the elastomer deterioration and reducing the preparation time. For applications in Hot Melt and Solvent-Based Adhesives, the resin promotes tack, wetting, cohesion, open time control and water repellency.

### Packaging and Storage:

Resins are supplied in 25 kg polyethylene bags, palletted and unitized. The Unilene® must be stored at temperatures below 40°C, and protected from direct sunlight, moisture and over pallets in order to avoid direct contact with the soil.

2 (two) years from production, since the recommended storage conditions are respected.
